I am looking forward to starting lessons again this fall. Welcome to new students, and welcome back to returning students!

Location:

Lessons held at 1st Presbyterian Church, 540 S Main St, Kalispell

*please enter through the side door facing 6th St, **ring the doorbell** when you arrive!

Calendar:

I will be following the calendar provided at the beginning of the year. This will show scheduled days off, holidays, professional development, recital dates, group lesson weeks, and other irregularities in the schedule.

Materials:

Please bring a notebook for assignments and all relevant lesson materials (books, loose sheet music, etc.)

Practice expectations:

Daily practice is extremely important for progress in piano lessons. That means, **you need to practice every day!** A good rule of thumb is to practice the same amount of time as the length of your lesson each day. The more prepared you are, the more we can cover.

Tuition:

Please pay tuition no later than the 1st lesson of each month.

A late fee of \$20 will be applied after the 20th of the month.

Your monthly rate guarantees 10 lessons/3 months, NOT 4 lessons per month. Monthly payments do not change if there are only 3 lessons, or 5 lessons in a month.

Payments can be made by check, cash, venmo, or paypal.

Makeups/Reschedules:

There are two “free” lessons build into the schedule this year. Outside of these two, if I need to cancel a lesson, I will work with you to schedule a makeup lesson. If you cancel, no makeup is guaranteed.

Recitals:

All students are expected to participate in all recitals, including the KAMTA Spring Festival.

Each recital is preceded by a “recital rehearsal” in which students play their recital pieces for each other in a group class setting. These group lessons count toward the 10 lessons each quarter.
